

# 2010 FREEDOM LAKE RULES

Aquifer Pure Water Source, Sand Beach, Picnic Tables & Grills, Swim Lanes, Slides, Diving Board, Volleyball, Wiffleball, Tetherball, Table Tennis, Horseshoes

## GENERAL

1. Swimming is allowed only when and where lifeguards are on duty.
2. Maximum water capacity = 525 persons.
3. A responsible adult must accompany children under 13.
4. Flotation devices are not permitted.
5. Incapable swimmers must stay in the shallow area (less than 4' deep) along the beach.
6. No alcoholic beverages allowed.
7. One person at a time on the slides.
8. Slide users must wait for previous person to move out of the way.
9. Slide users must be at least 32 inches tall.
10. Water area in front of slides must always remain clear.
11. Everyone must go down slides feet first in the sitting position.
12. Anyone climbing down the slides must face the slide climbing down.
13. No sitting or hanging on ropes.
14. No smoking on the beach.
15. Keep clear of the boat and area in front of lifeguard chairs.
16. Fishing is not permitted.
17. Animals are not allowed in the park.
18. Profanity is prohibited.
19. No glass containers are allowed anywhere near beach or water.
20. Non-toilet trained youth must wear protective undergarments.
21. Regular diapers are prohibited in the water.
22. Diapers must be changed in the bathhouse.

## DEEP WATER

1. Children over 6 and under 13 must pass a deep water swim test each year before entering the water area including: U dock, deep water slide, diving board. Requirements: Crawl stroke one U dock length, tread water 1 min. and backstroke unaided with convincing technique and stamina. Test given daily at 12:45 & 4:45pm. (limit: one test/person/day)
2. Children under 7 are not permitted in the deep water.
3. Individuals of any age viewed to be an incapable swimmer by a lifeguard may not enter the deep water area until passing a subsequent deep water swim test.

### **Deep Water Slide**

- a. Use of the Deep Water Slide is limited to when a lifeguard is on duty at the slide guard chair or on the rescue board in front of the slide. No jumping off the exit ladder platform by the deep water slide.
- b. See General Rules #7-11.

### **Diving Board**

- a. One bounce only.
- b. Straight forward dives or jumps only.
- c. Only one person allowed on board at a time.
- d. Diver must wait for previous diver to move completely out of the way.

### **Raft**

- a. No back flips or back dives.
- b. No pushing or running.
- c. No diving/jumping over the railing seats.
- d. No swimming under the raft.

### **U Dock**

- a. Public use of the U dock swim lanes are for experienced, serious users.
- b. Priority use of the U dock lanes is for pre-registered swim instruction and swim team.
- c. No swimming under the U dock
- d. No pushing or running.

## CLOSING

Freedom Lake will close when, at the discretion of the Waterfront Director or Assistant Waterfront Director, the weather or water conditions are considered undesirable and/or unsafe.
